Come join us for a weekend of climbing, rappelling, hiking, camping, and venturing. This annual activity is available to all registered Venture Crews or individual Ventures only. Individual Ventures attending will need to join with a registered crew for this event.

The Venturing District will provide all the climbing and rappelling equipment. You may bring your own harnesses, helmets, shoes, etc if you like

(but not required) provided that they meet safety standards. Please leave any ropes, carabineers, belay devices, webbing etc at home. We will provide all safety and emergency equipment.

Agenda

- Arrive Friday night and set up Camp

- Saturday morning– Awake, eat breakfast and secure camp. We will take a short hike to the climbing area. Bring water, sack lunches and rain gear. Climbing and rappelling will run until 4:30pm.

- Saturday evening – units will provide their own evening program as they choose. The evening meal is a great opportunity for crews to eat communally and meet other Ventures. Any Crew or Crews who would like to host an evening campfire would be welcome.

- Sunday morning- break camp and return to Tulsa. Worship services conducted as is the tradition of each unit.

There will be an \$8 per person fee payable to the Scout Office by Nov 13th to reserve your place for this event.

Fee covers campsite and supplemental accident insurance. There will be no need to pay park rangers for your campsite when you arrive.

Each unit must file their own Tour Permit

Units are responsible for their own transportation, meals, and two-deep leadership.

Robbers Cave State Park is located in the scenic, hilly woodlands of the San Bois Mountains of southeast Oklahoma. A favorite of rappellers, equestrians, hikers and outdoor lovers. Robbers Cave enjoys notoriety as a former hideout for outlaws. The park and adjoining wildlife management area, including Lake Wayne Wallace, offers acres of discovery and enjoyment including trout fishing in season, boating, hunting, trails for hikers and horses, sandstone cliffs for climbing and rappelling, and fall foliage viewing.

Directions from Tulsa:

take US-75 S toward GLENPOOL/OKMULGEE.

Merge onto INDIAN NATION TURNPIKE S (Portions toll).

Take the US-270/OK-1 exit, EXIT 70, toward MCALESTER/CALVIN

Turn LEFT onto US-270 E/OK-1 E. Take the OK-31 ramp toward KREBS.

Turn SLIGHT RIGHT onto OK-31/WASHINGTON ST. Continue to follow OK-31.

Turn SLIGHT RIGHT onto CR-E1440. CR-E1440 becomes unnamed road.

Stay STRAIGHT to go onto BOWERS RD.

Turn RIGHT onto CLONSILLA HILL RD.

Turn LEFT onto BOWERS RD.

Turn LEFT onto US-270.

Turn RIGHT onto US2 (Park Road) 5 miles to park entrance.

Total distance aprox 120 miles.

For directions to our campsite; check in at the park entrance and tell them you are with the Indian Nations Council or the Climbing and Rappelling weekend.
